

St Edmund's Catholic Primary and Nursery School and St Patrick's Catholic School are Voluntary Aided Schools administered by a federated Governing Body.

The Governing Body is made up of representatives from various groups that make up our school community – parents, staff, the Local Authority, the local community and the Parish.

Our governors work as a team, in close co-operation with the Executive Headteacher and all staff. All governors and staff contribute to the Catholic character of the school and they are responsible for making decisions about the management of the school. Governors help to ensure that all children have the best opportunity of achieving their potential in a happy and safe environment.

The full Governing Body meets at least once a term. All Governors serve for a term of four years

There are also sub-committees within the Governing Body

- Resources – to oversee finances, staffing and the maintenance of school buildings
- Mission and Strategy – to monitor and evaluate the Catholic life of the school
- Standards and Provision – to monitor the academic performance and progress of our children.
